Waste Centre Fees

Waste centre fees are to be priced as though disposing of clean fill.

When selected to perform works for CoL if non-clean fill items are to be disposed the Contractor shall be reimbursed in accordance with waste fees. Provision of waste centre dockets will be required to facilitate the reimbursement.

Q1. Query raised regarding confidentiality of Pricing

A1. Item 1.11.3 on the Tender Form that state the name of the successful Tenderer and their price will be presented in Council reports and shall be made public is a standard item on the CoL Tender template. It does not apply in the case of Multi Use Registers or Standing Contracts.

The name of parties selected to join the Multi Use Register or Standing Contracts panel may be made public but pricing information will remain confidential at all times.

Q2. Query on column format of schedules

A2. Please note Column in Schedule of Rates marked as Qty. should be titled Rate exc. GST.

New schedules have been released in both word and excel format with this updated information.

Q3. If the Contractor is required to submit a construction management plan upon request by the project Superintendent, how is this cost recovered?

A3. A construction management plan may be required on high risk or sensitive works. The rate for development of this plan will be negotiated with the Contractor selected for the works and as such is not a priced item on the Schedule of Rates.

Should the Contractor be dissatisfied with the negotiated rate they are under no obligation to accept the CoL request to perform works.

Q4. Query raised regarding Traffic Management

A4. Please refer Schedule 12 Dayworks for any additional traffic management requirements. CoL will pay as per site requirements.

Q5. Item A9.0 requires adjusting existing services to suit new design levels surface levels, is this work performed before final surface application (ie prior to asphalt, concrete, topsoiling, etc) or after final surface application into that newly constructed finish?

A5. The methodology used for raising surface levels is up to the discretion of the Contractor or instruction by CoL Project Manager/Superintendent.

Q6. The project Schedule of rates tenders are called for in the 12 listed categories, if acceptance in a particular category is successful and the project then involves additional works shown in that category, are all rates as tendered used, treated as a variation being priced accordingly or outsourced for management by others?

A6. Any price submitted by a Contractor within a category that are subsequently accepted will be used for all works within that category for the period of contract.

Q7. With regard to the Local Government Act, suppliers may apply for registration on the panel at any time provided they have not had an application rejected within the preceding 12 months. What is the definition of rejected and how does this relate to the current tender process?

A7. Rejection is deemed as being unsuccessful in a Contractors tender submission to one or more categories list in the Form 6, Schedule of Rates and Prices.

A Contractor deemed unsuccessful will be provided a letter clearly stating in what areas they have been unsuccessful and therefore must wait 12 month before re-submitting their application for consideration to join the panel in that category or categories.
